



COW PASTURE GOLF

What is it?

A morning of “no rules” golf, using tennis balls and hitting implements of any sort, played around a 15 hole “golf course” in a pasture at The Whistle Stop farm, off Deschutes Market Rd. on the way to Bend (65325 Pleasant Ridge Road).

When is it?

Competition will take place on Saturday, 7 July, starting around 0730.

What does it cost?

\$35 for an individual

\$120 for a team*, (which saves \$20).

**Teams are preferred, but 4 individuals can make up a “team” on the spot. “Scramble” format.*

Sponsorships

To sponsor a “hole” or a “tee”, the cost is \$65, which allows you to decorate YOUR portion of the “golf course” in any fashion you see fit.

Schedule

Sponsored Hole/Tee decoration times

5 July from noon–7PM, & 6 July from 10AM–3PM

Saturday, July 7th

Sign In starts at 7AM, 1st Start at 7:30AM

- The “tee” areas will be designated by a flag with the appropriate number on it.
- The “hole” will consist of a short piece of PVC pipe, roughly 12” in diameter, located various distances from annotated “tee” areas.
- Maps will be provided at sign in.
- Tennis balls and hitting implements (clubs) will be provided, or you may bring your own.
- Refreshments will be available (hamburgers and watermelon).
- We (the organizers) cannot provide adult beverages, but liquid refreshments may be brought in and consumed, IN MODERATION.

All proceeds will benefit Central Oregon Veterans, and all monies contributed are tax deductible through the American Legion.
